

## **INFO AND PARTICIPATION**

The “Bodies, Places, Borders” initiative is entirely self-managed and self-funded: its success depends on the active collaboration and mutual respect of all participants.

## **COSTS**

The campsite has a daily per-person rate to be paid to the site owners.

There are no additional costs for tents or vehicles.

Various expenses (transport, food, equipment) are covered through voluntary donations.

## **FOOD**

Meals, for which a small contribution will be requested, will be prepared by a self-organized kitchen group, offering vegetarian and vegan dishes made with ingredients from local gardens. You are welcome to help out in the kitchen signing up for one or more shifts at the start of the event.

## **TRANSPORT AND MOBILITY**

The campsite is located between the provinces of Lecce, Brindisi and Taranto, about 5 kilometers from the sea. If you have the possibility to bring or rent a bicycle, do so! The roads are flat and easy to cycle on.

If you come by train or without your own transport and you need a ride to the campsite, let us know by email. Finally, we ask those planning to arrive by camper or van to let us know in advance so we can organize the space.

We ask all participants to inform us timely about the number of people attending and whether they will be staying in tents, vans or other accommodation.

## **TRANSLATIONS**

We expect participants from different countries. We are considering arranging equipment for simultaneous translation; in any case, we ask anyone willing to help with translations to let us know by email.
